EGC Training FAQ - Basic Personal Protection Outside The Home

Who do I contact? For registration or information, please contact the training registrar at registrar@beegc.org

<u>How much does it cost?</u> For BEEGC and BERPC members, the cost is \$200 for Part 1. For non-club members, the cost is \$275 for Part 1. For Part 2 (advanced shooting techniques), club member cost is \$65, for non-members \$75. Part 2 of the course is optional but you must complete Part 1 as a pre-requisite for Part 2.

<u>What time do the classes start?</u> The Friday evening lecture session starts at 6:00PM and will run for approximately 2 hours. The Part 1 Sunday classroom and range session will begin at 10:30AM and finish around 6:00PM. The Part 2 range session will begin at 10:30AM and finish around 4:00PM. All times are subject to change.

<u>Where are classes held?</u> The lecture and classroom/range sessions will be held at West Coast Armory North, 11714 Airport Road, Everett, WA. The classroom is located upstairs.

Should I bring my gun? You will need to bring your own firearm for the range portion of the class but you will not need it for the Friday evening lecture session. **No student owned or student provided guns or live ammunition are allowed in the classroom at any time**. If you are carrying concealed, we ask that you leave your firearm secured in your vehicle during the class. For Part 1 of the class, you will also need to bring approximately 150 rounds of ammunition (no aluminum or steel case ammunition is allowed, per range rules). For Part 2 of the class, you will need to bring approximately 150 rounds of ammunition.

<u>What caliber should I use?</u> We recommend that you use a defensive caliber such as .38/.357 for a revolver or 9mm, 40 S&W or 45 ACP for semi-auto pistols. Exceptions to this based on need are perfectly acceptable.

<u>What should I bring my gun in?</u> For both Parts 1 and 2 of the class, you will need a suitable belt or paddle holster or a concealed carry purse or handbag. You will also need at least 2 magazines or a speed loader (if you're using a revolver).

<u>Will we be taking a lunch break?</u> Yes, you may bring your own lunch/snacks or there are nearby fast food restaurants. There are vending machines on site as well. We will take approximately 30 minutes for lunch.

Registration and cancellation policy: Eligible participants may register for a class by filling out the registration form, including payment, and mailing it to the address specified on the form. Classes will be filled on a first paid, first reserved basis. If you cancel your registration once you've signed up, it must be done no later than 1 week prior to the start of that class. 50% of the class fee will be refunded if you adhere to the cancellation policy or you will be given the opportunity to sign up for the next available class. If you cancel your registration otherwise or fail to attend the class, no refund will be issued. You will be given the opportunity to sign up again for the next available class with no additional fee if you so choose. If a class is cancelled due to not enough participants or other circumstances beyond the control of BEEGC, students will receive a full refund. Classes have a minimum enrollment of 6 students and a maximum of 12 students.

<u>What benefits do I get for joining the Boeing Employees Everett Gun Club?</u> If you are taking any training courses, the first benefit you will receive is the member price for the classes. You will be placed on the club's e-mailing list and receive the minutes for our meetings, upcoming shooting events and other club activities. Club events include rifle and pistol shoots. We also bring in various guest speakers for our meetings throughout the year. You will also be joining the ranks of one of the finest groups of people at Boeing.
