



2015 Training Courses

The club offers training and education courses for both pistol and rifle. Each course is taught by NRA certified instructors and club training staff. Classes are generally kept small (less than 12 students) to ensure individual instruction and coaching.

Courses are open to ALL Boeing employees, retirees, contractors, customers and their families

NRA Basic Pistol (March 8th and March 29th)

This class covers essential safety rules, basic pistol skills, pistol function, parts, and safe ownership and operation. Safety is STRONGLY emphasized. \$60 for club members (\$80 for non-members). The registration cut-off dates are February 20th for the 3/8 class and March 13th for the 3/29 class.

Basic Personal Protection Inside The Home (May 15th and 17th)

This two session class covers the knowledge, attitude and skills necessary for the safe defensive use of handguns. Includes classroom preparation, range exercises and discussions with both an attorney and a law enforcement officer. Introduces the student to self-defense concepts beyond the use of a firearm. Completion of the Basic Pistol Course or an equivalent is a prerequisite. \$125 for club members (\$175 for non-members). The registration cut-off date is May 1st.

Basic Personal Protection Outside The Home (July 31st and August 2nd for Part 1, August 9th for Part 2—optional)

This two part course teaches students the knowledge, skills and attitude essential for avoiding dangerous confrontations and for the safe, effective and responsible use of a concealed pistol for self-defense outside the home. Students have the opportunity to attend this course using a quality strong side hip holster that covers the trigger, or a holster purse. From a review of safe firearms handling and proper mindset to presentation from concealment and multiple shooting positions, this course contains the essential skills and techniques needed to prevail in a life-threatening situation. Part 1 of the course covers the essential knowledge and skills that must be mastered in order to carry, store, and use a firearm safely and effectively for personal protection outside the home. Part 2 of the course (optional) teaches advanced shooting skills. Part 1 of the course is \$200 for club members (\$275 for non-members). Part 2 of the course is \$65 for members (\$75 for non-members). The registration cut-off date is July 17th.
